

Saving a Youtube video to your USB


- 1. Open the site at http://yoodownload.com/
- 2. Go to Youtube and find the video you want to download. Remember to check if there is any Copyright laws attached to the video
- 3. Once you have found your video, copy the URL/address of the page you are on
- 4. Switch back to Yoo Download and paste the URL into the space provided, like the image below




5. Now click in the box that says, I am not a robot, and you will get an image like the one I below



6. Looking at the picture above, I can see 5 squares that contain part of vehicles, so I select each square like the image on the next page



7. I then click Next, and if I was successful, I get the next image. Don't worry if you missed something, you will get another image to try.



- 8. Now click on the word that says Download which is at the right side of your URL you pasted earlier
- 9. This will take you to a new page, but look carefully and read the new page, you have options on video formats and sizes
